> The auction part of the 19-artist show at Artist's Space is over, but the works remain on view (105 Hudson Street, January 2-7). It's one of those groups which assure us that as nutty, corny, and wet behind the ears as the new generation can be, young artists have a lot on the ball and are earnest about their experiments. Livio Saganic's wall and floor sculptures made of flagstone, Judy Pfaff's hallway meta-morphosing into a crazy quilt, Farrell Brickhouse's crusty little paintings-asobjects, Michael Harvey's jigsaw puzzles with incongruously interchangeable parts, Michael Zwack's enigmatic images cast in concrete, Joanee Seltzer's autobiographical photomontages, R. M. Fischer's slyly punning formal amplifications of newspaper photos, and Paul McMahon's pastel obscurations of such photographs all stand out as especially adventuresome. And the company they keep is hardly less quirky and refreshing.
