

THE FLOW OF IMAGES LIKE RIVERS STREAMING COMING DOWN FROM THE HIGHTS IRREVOCABLY WILL MINGLE, MINGLE AT SEA. YES YES, OUR THOUGHTS MUST TAKE ON NEW SHAPES, EVA-PORATE LIKE WATER IN THE FACE OF REALITY: A SUN! LOOK HOW THE WATER FALLS!
